

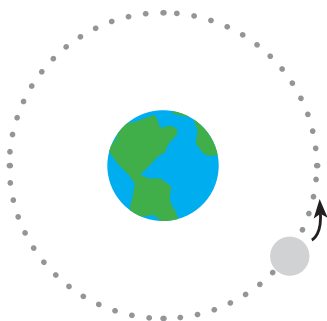


The Podium

Looking Up!

Stand outside the Podium and look up at the ArcelorMittal Orbit.

Q What is an orbit? A path 1 object takes around another. The moon orbits the earth.



1. Try and follow the loops of the ArcelorMittal Orbit with your arm - up, down and around.

The Canopy

Walk over to the foot of the ArcelorMittal Orbit - You are now under the Canopy. Wait until you can use the lift.

Q Fantastic Facts

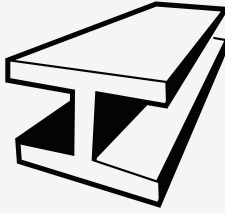
It is the **TALLEST** sculpture in Britain – 114.5m

It was designed for the 2012 London Olympic Games & Paralympic Games

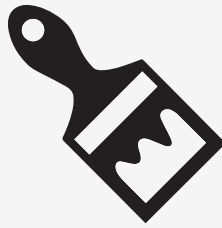
During the games there were 5,000 visitors a day

2,000 tonnes of steel



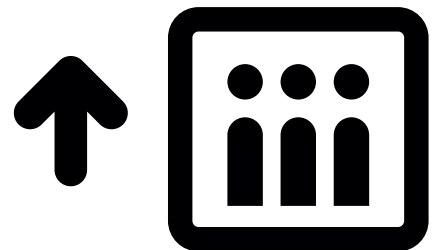
19,000 litres of paint

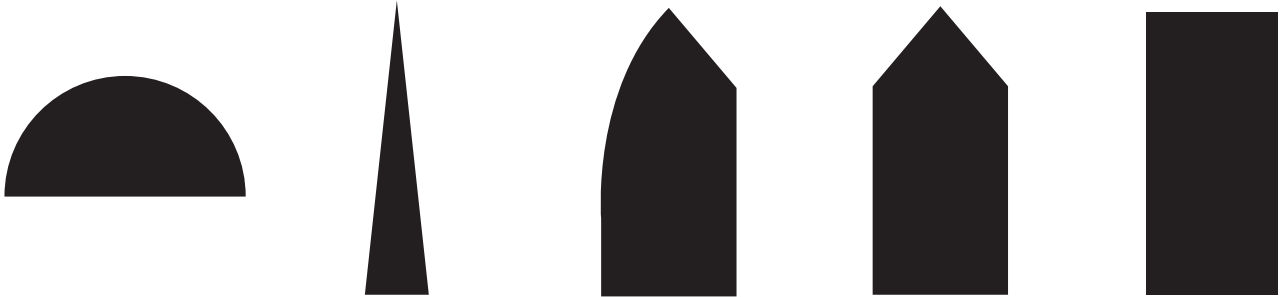

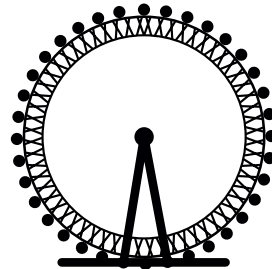

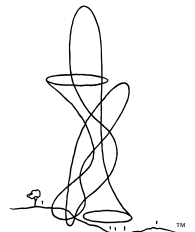
