Anish Kapoor has invited Belgian artist Carsten Höller to create a giant slide for the ArcelorMittal Orbit in London. This is a unique collaboration between two of the world's leading artists and will be a major new art installation for the capital.

The slide will be opening in the Spring of 2016 and will be the world's longest and tallest tunnel slide, with transparent sections so you can marvel at the view, as you make the 40 second descent.

# COACH PARKING

The ArcelorMittal Orbit has allocated pick up and set down points for coaches, 5 metres from the attraction. Please inform us if you will be travelling by coach when making your booking.

Coach parking facilities are located on the ground floor of the multi-storey car park in the north end of Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, just off Waterden Road.
